

Scott Koter Biography



Scott Koter retired as Assistant Superintendent for the Kiski Area School District after a distinguished career as a band director and administrator. His ensembles earned numerous state and BOA regional titles, including seven Grand National Finalist appearances and two class championships, with featured performances at the Midwest Clinic, MENC, IAJE, and PMEA conventions.

In the marching arts, Scott served as program coordinator for The Cavaliers and Santa Clara Vanguard, contributing to six DCI World Championships and 15 top-three finishes. He has guided numerous drum corps and high school programs to UIL, state, regional, and national honors. Scott also served as DCI Percussion Caption Administrator and task force member for nearly a decade, and has adjudicated championship finals for DCI, BOA, and WGI.

A member of the DCI and PFCJ Halls of Fame, Scott is a designer for Fannin Musical Productions (FMP) and a consultant for the Santa Clara Vanguard and various high school programs. He is the author of *A Roadmap for Marching Band Design: 6 Steps to Clarity*, published by FMP.
