Parking / Vehicles

- Trucks and buses are permitted to park in the parking designated on the Truck Flow Map (see diagrams).
- Each performing group will be allotted four (4) parking passes. Buses and trucks do not need a parking pass.
- Performing groups' trucks, buses, and vehicles with parking passes should arrive at Lot Warm-Up no earlier than the "Alpha Lot Check-In" time listed on the logistical schedule.
- Trucks and buses should move to the Truck and Bus parking once reload is done. Once group has performed, trucks should meet performers in reload zone for reload or reload in truck and bus parking.
- Trucks and buses must be moved out of the designated loading area 30 minutes after the group's performance concludes.

Dressing Facilities, Restrooms, & First Aid

- Dressing facilities are limited. Please come in competitive attire.
- First Aid is available at the performance exit.

General Group Logistics

- Group Check-In will be available at the Group Entrance.
- Warm-up will be conducted in the Alpha Lot Warm-Up.
 - Alternative warmup zones will be available for inclement weather.

- Groups are not permitted to run power from any building power access. Please plan to use generators should you want power in unloading, warm up, and/or loading. Generators are NOT permitted inside the building.
- Anyone who is entering the arena with a performing group must have a valid badge or wristband. If there is a person entering with a performing group who has a valid spectator ticket, they must have their ticket scanned and the appropriate wristband on prior to entering the arena. Failure to secure a wristband prior to entering the arena will prohibit their entrance to the arena with the performing group.

Competition Area

- The competition area floor is concrete and covered with black tarp.
- The competition area is 62' x 100'. Please see the competition area layout for more details.
- WGI will provide two 20 amp dedicated circuits on the front and back sidelines for performing groups. There are indoor floor folding facilities available.

Campbell County Entry Procedures

- Box Office is credit card only and concession stands are cash or card. They will accept all major credit cards, debit cards, Apple Pay, and Google Pay.
- No equipment will be allowed in the main spectator arena entrances. Equipment may only enter the building through the designated performance entrance at the docking bay. Flag bags, equipment bags, and cymbal bags are not permitted through the spectator entrance.
- Prohibited Items: Including, but not limited to, firearms, weapons of any kind, outside food and drink, strollers, signs larger than 8.5" x 11", tripods, balloons, animals (with the exception of service animals), camera lenses longer than eight (8) inches, laser pointers, and noisemakers.
- All tickets are mobile delivery and must be scanned to obtain a wristband prior to entering the arena.

Safety and Weather Communications

- In the event of inclement weather and/or other safety concerns, information will be sent to the groups from WGI via CompetitionSuite. Please be prepared to disseminate the information to your group, staff, volunteers, etc.
- Tents are not suitable for sheltering in the event of inclement weather.

Campbell County Prohibited Items

- Aerosol Cans
- Alcohol, drugs, illegal substances, or any paraphernalia associated with drug use
- Animals
- Audio/Video recorders
- Backpacks
- Bags larger than 12" by 6" by 12"
- Balloons
- Camera cases
- Cameras with removable lenses or flash
- Cans, bottles, coolers, or other similar containers
- Fireworks
- Flags, signs, or banners
- Flowers or Gifts
- Hover boards
- Laser pens/pointers
- Noisemakers such as air horns or whistles
- Outside food or drinks or personal drink containers
- Tripods, monopods, other professional photography equipment or selfie sticks
- Pepper spray/mace
- Weapons of any type, including chains, knives, firearms, and spiked jewelry
- No Smoking or Vaping is permitted at Truist Arena
- **Other items deemed unacceptable by event/building management**



If an item is revealed during a search, patrons may dispose of the item, or they may return the item to their vehicle. Truist Arena does not safeguard any personal belongings or items of any type.

Campbell County Security Screening Procedures – General Public

- Please plan to arrive early.
- Patrons have the option of discarding prohibited items at entrance point or taking items back to their vehicle.

Campbell County Clear Bag Policy - In Effect at Spectator Entry and Performer & Staff Re-Entry


- 12" by 6" by 12" clear bag + 1 clutch bag per guest permitted.
- One Gallon Ziploc storage bag permitted.
- One Clutch bag no larger than 4.5" x 6.5" with or without straps permitted. Clutch does not have to be clear.
- Exceptions can be made for Medical bags after a proper inspection.

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

Performing Groups


Performing groups' trucks, buses, and vehicles with parking passes should arrive at Alpha Warm-Up Lot at "Alpha Lot Check-In" time (see Logistical Schedule). Unload in Warm Up Area. Trucks and buses should move to the Truck and Bus parking once reload is done. Once group has performed, trucks should meet performers in reload zone for reload or reload in truck and bus parking.

Performing group vehicles with WGI parking passes may park in the Truck and bus lot or Spectator Parking for free.

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
Alpha Lot Map - Lot Spaces approx. 70' x 30'

Percussion & Winds World Championships Competition Area Campbell County HS | Alexandria, KY

All WGI contest sites must have a minimum of seventy feet by one hundred feet (70' x 100') to accommodate a "safety zone" of five (5) feet from any spectator seating. This will ensure the minimum sixty-foot by ninety-foot (60' x 90') competition area within the minimum seventy feet by one hundred feet (70' x 100') of the contest site. If no spectators are seated on the left and right sides, then the safety zone will be eliminated on the left and right sides of the competition area and extend to the walls.

The competition area at this event measures 62' x 100'. All performing groups must be prepared to perform within that area. Floors (tarps) may not extend into the safety zones per rules found in the WGI Adjudication Manual and Rulebook.
