- The arena is situated on three floors:
 - The lower level is the competition area, color guard first aid, and staging area.
 - The walk-in level is Performance Check-In, body and equipment warm up, ticket office, sound check, entrance to the arena for competing color guards, entrances for spectators and non-performing color guards. (Photography is on the west concourse.)
 - On the upper level is Director Check In & WGI Headquarters (entrance is at walk-in level, Boesch Lounge).
- Parking for color guards and spectators is abundant. Spectators enter at Parking Gate C or D ONLY.
- Each color guard will be allotted 4 parking passes. Buses and trucks do not need a parking pass and will be permitted parking in the Bus/Truck Lot. See maps for details and traffic flow.
- University of Dayton has implemented security screening procedures. Please instruct everyone traveling with you to allow extra time upon arrival. A list of prohibited items is located in this packet. Absolutely no color guard equipment will be permitted in the spectator entrance.
- There are NO dressing facilities available. Performing members should arrive at the arena in competitive attire.
- A 12' black drape will adorn the back stands of the competition area.
- Music is permitted in body and equipment warm up at moderate levels. In body warm up, the sound system should be placed in the corner of the room. WGI does not provide a sound system in any warm up area. If you wish to use music, please provide your own system.
- The floor surface is concrete. A black tarp will cover the entire competition area. A black tarp will cover the entire competition area. The black strips will be placed approximately 9.5 feet apart from the front to the back of the performance floor. The last strip at the back will vary in width.
- The competition area is 106' X 78'. Please see the floor plan for more details.
- An electrical outlet will be available at the front and back side line.
- There is a scoreboard that hangs in the middle of the performance floor. Distance from the floor to the bottom of the scoreboard is 32'.
- The mixing board for the sound system and the sound person will be located in the front stands. The WGI sound person will have control of the level of sound. See contest info packet for sound check times.
- There are no indoor floor folding facilities available. In the event of inclement weather, please see the next page.

Prop Storage

A second tent for covered floor/prop storage for color guard will be utilized at UD Arena at the World Championships for inclement weather. Each group will be allotted an area measuring appx 12' x 20' and will be allowed to occupy this area up to 60 minutes before their performance check-in time. We highly encourage an individual to stay with the floor/props at all times while in the tent.

Floor Refolding

Floor refolding may take place in the stadium concessions area across the parking lot.

Groups will not be allowed to refold their floors in the performance venue at the conclusion of world championship events.



UD ARENA PROCEDURES

UD ARENA IS CASHLESS: Box Office, Concession stands, and the UD team store are **100% cashless**. They will accept all major credit cards, debit cards, Apple Pay and Google Pay.

METAL DETECTORS: All persons will walk through a metal detector or be screened with a hand-held metal detector, to search for prohibited items any time they enter or re-enter the building. **Please allow extra time** to your arrival to the arena to account for this process.

NO COLOR GUARD EQUIPMENT will be allowed in the main spectator arena entrances. Equipment may only enter the building through the warm/up guard check-in entrance and the designated performance entrance at the top of the tunnel. *(See additional information on where groups can leave equipment and props outside backstage).*

ALL BAGS ARE SUBJECT TO SEARCH. No backpacks are permitted in the spectator entrances. We ask you to please limit the number of bags/purses/small backpacks being brought into the arena. Personal bags may be allowed after a thorough inspection. Bags larger than 16x16x8 are not permitted except for diaper bags and medical equipment, which are subject to inspection at any time. **Flag bags/ equipment bags/ cymbal bags are not permitted in the spectator entrances.**

PROHIBITED ITEMS: Including, but not limited to: firearms, weapons of any kind, illegal substances, hazardous materials, outside food and drink, strollers, signs larger than 8.5 x 11, tripods, balloons, animals (with the exception of service animals), camera lenses longer than eight (8) inches, laser pointers, and noisemakers.

University of Dayton Arena WGI Truck Unload/Reload Lot and Prop Storage Tent Information

WGI will cone off 18 lettered spaces that will be approximately 50' x 36' each behind UD arena for prop/floor truck unloading/reloading. In addition to the lettered parking spaces, there is a prop storage tent now available with 14 numbered spaces measuring approximately 17'x12.5'. *Storage Tent Double Door Dimensions will be taken when the doors are installed and then sent to the groups via CompetitionSuite Text.*

Groups will have a published unload time (*appx 90 minutes prior to their performance time*) to enter their designated space. Trucks/trailers will be permitted to park in those designated spots. Buses will still park in the west lot.

Groups will not be permitted to park at the tent to unload. Groups must unload in their designated parking spot until reload and push into the prop storage tent.

Groups who have props/floors that take up a larger footprint than the 17' x 12.5' of available space or who have props that will not fit in the double door of the storage tent will need to be prepared to cover additional equipment/props with a tarp, or some other protective cover in case of inclement weather in your lettered lot parking spot.

Color guard equipment will remain with your props/floors until your designated performance check-in time. Props and floors will remain in the prop storage space until you are given instructions to move towards the tunnel entrance by WGI personnel. Please note that absolutely no color guard equipment will be allowed in the spectator doors.

Each group will receive a "Golden Ticket" upon arrival with your designated departure time from the lettered parking space. Trucks/trailers will remain in the designated spot until your group has reloaded after your performance. Groups who fail to remove their vehicles by the designated time may be subject to a penalty.

These designated prop storage spaces will only be available at UD Arena. WGI Staff & Volunteers will direct groups in and out of their assigned letter space. Groups are responsible for all items & vehicles left in their assigned letter space.

(WGI and/or the University of Dayton Arena is not responsible for lost or stolen items.)




Interval Time Line



Color Guard World Championships Competition Area University of Dayton Arena, Dayton, OH

All WGI contest sites must have a minimum of seventy by one hundred feet (70' x 100') to accommodate a "safety zone" of five (5) feet from any spectator seating. If no spectators are seated on the left and right sides, then the safety zone will be eliminated on the left and right sides of the competition area and could extend to a maximum of 106' X 78'.

The "competition area" at this event measures 106' X 78'. All performing groups must be prepared to perform within that area. Floors (tarps) may not extend into the safety zones per rules found in the WGI Adjudication Manual and Rulebook.


